We Welcome Your Wedding

Gretna United Methodist Church

welcomes you and provides these guidelines to assist you in planning your wedding.

Scheduling

The following days are not available for weddings:
Sundays, Holiday Weekends, New Year's Eve, New Year's Day, Holy Week, Easter,
Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, and Christmas Day.
Weddings must be scheduled before 6 pm.
Fees must be paid in full in order to secure the date of the wedding.

Minister

Weddings at Gretna United Methodist Church are usually preformed by our pastor.

If you desire another minister to assist or to conduct the ceremony,
you may make arrangements through our pastor and we will gladly extend our welcome.

Wedding Coordinator

From start to finish, our Wedding Coordinator will assist you in planning the details of your wedding at GUMC.

Music

If you desire a musician or soloist, the church may provide one at an additional cost to be arranged directly with the musician.

The Sanctuary

The sanctuary seating capacity is 350.

Parking and Accessibility

There is ample off-street parking with a covered entrance. The church buildings conform to current accessibility standards.

Conference and Choir Rooms

The wedding party should arrive dressed in their wedding attire. The Conference Room will be available for the bride and attendance, and the Choir Room will be available for the groom and attendants.

Rehearsal

Please encourage all members of the wedding party and ushers to attend the rehearsal and to be punctual.

The church will be open 15 minutes prior to a scheduled rehearsal.

A period of one hour will be reserved for the rehearsal.

The minister will conduct the rehearsal.

The marriage license must be brought to the rehearsal.

Decorations

Your florist may call the church and arrange for access to the sanctuary.

Please advise your florist or decorator that:

Only drip-less candles may be used.

Carpet and furnishings must be protected from wax, water, soil from potted plants, etc.

The use of nails, tacks, pins, glue and tape is prohibited.

Decorations may not obscure the symbols of the church, nor should any of the altar ware or furnishings be moved without the prior approval of the pastor or wedding coordinator.

Ushers

Ushers play a very important role in the seating of guests and family members.

It is helpful to have as many as four ushers,
and it is very important that all four be present for the rehearsal.

Use of Alcohol

Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on church property or in church buildings, nor should any of the wedding party come to the church under the influence of alcohol.

Violation of this policy could result in the forfeiture of your deposit.

Smoking

Smoking is not permitted in any of the church buildings.

No Rice, Please

For safety reasons, the throwing of rice or birdseed is not permitted. Flower petals may be thrown inside or outside the sanctuary.

Bubbles may be blown outside only.

Personal Items

The Church cannot be liable for personal items lost, damaged or stolen.

We want your wedding to be a wonderful time for you, your families and friends!

Fees

All fees must be paid in full to secure the wedding date on the church calendar.

For Members

who have been on the
church rolls for 6 months or more
\$500
This fee covers the costs of
the Sanctuary usage,
Conference and Choir Rooms usage,
Wedding Coordinator, Sexton,
wedding, rehearsal,
and Minister.

For Non-Members

\$1500
including a deposit of \$500
to be refunded if there is no damage
to church property
and wedding guidelines
are observed

The fees cover the costs of the Sanctuary usage, the Conference and Choir Rooms, Wedding Coordinator, Sexton, wedding, rehearsal, and Minister.

NOTE: If an Audio Technician is also needed, please advise the Wedding Coordinator.
